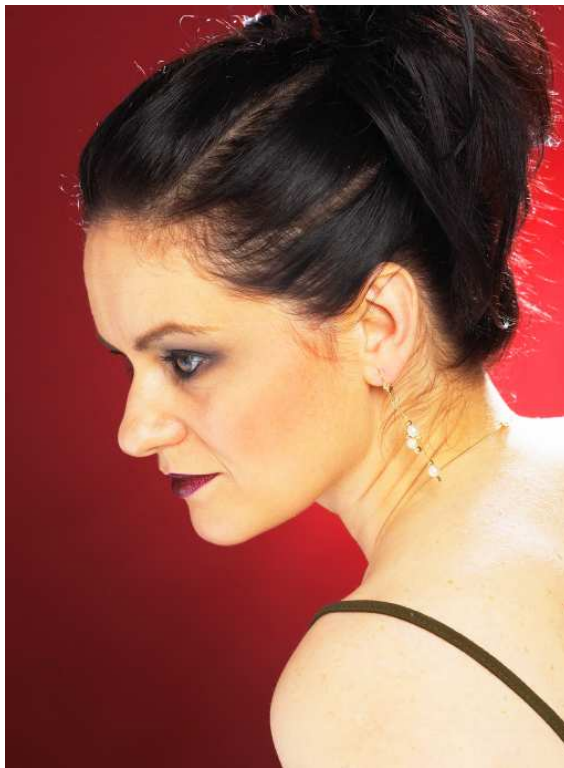


MUSICA FLOREA

GUEST SOPRANO ANNA HLAVENKOVÁ

Soprano Anna Hlavenková's international career began in 1989 with multiple performances and recordings with Musica Antiqua Prague. Since 1994 she has performed and recorded with Musica Florea with whom the recordings of works by J.D. Zelenka are of particular note for garnering numerous international awards and prizes. She has since become a favorite lyric soprano of ensembles and orchestras dedicated to authentic interpretation of Baroque repertoire.



As a member of Musica Bohemica Prague, Ms. Hlavenková is widely known for performances of 19th and 20th century songs and folk songs. Some of her recent major appearances have included the title role in Purcell's *Dido and Aeneas* at the Pilsen Opera and solo performances at the Festival of Czech Music in New York City. Ms. Hlavenková regularly appears on radio and television
